The California Community College Initiative:

- **Guarantees independence from politics**
- **Guarantees minimum funding for growth**
- **Guarantees \$15 per unit fees that can only rise with the cost of living**

California Community Colleges are the only opportunity that many Californians have to get a college education. California’s tradition of low student fees and financial aid has made community colleges a gateway to a better life for millions of Californians.

The California Community College Initiative requires minimum levels of state funding for community colleges. It allows community college funding to increase with the growing student population without raising taxes.

The California Community College Initiative provides stable, affordable and predictable student fees by setting fees at \$15 per unit and limiting future fee increases to no more than the cost of living.

The California Community College Initiative takes politics out of the community colleges by establishing in the state constitution a system of independent public community college districts and Board of Governors.

This initiative will help ensure that California Community Colleges continue to fulfill their mission of providing affordable education and advancing California’s economic growth by continuously improving the state’s workforce.

Supporters of the California Community College Initiative turned in more than 900,000 signatures in January and the measure is expected to qualify soon for placement on the next statewide ballot.
