The California Community College Initiative:

- **Guarantees minimum funding for growth**
- **Guarantees \$15 per unit fees that can only rise with the cost of living**
- **Guarantees a system of independent community college districts**

The Initiative has qualified for the next statewide election on February 5, 2008.

California Community Colleges are the only opportunity that many Californians have to get a college education. California’s tradition of low student fees and financial aid has made community colleges a gateway to a better life for millions of Californians.

The California Community College Initiative requires minimum levels of state funding for community colleges. It allows community college funding to increase with the growing student population without raising taxes.

The California Community College Initiative provides stable, affordable and predictable student fees by setting fees at \$15 per unit and limiting future fee increases to no more than the cost of living.

The California Community College Initiative guarantees a stable system of independent public community college districts and Board of Governors.

This initiative will help ensure that California Community Colleges continue to fulfill their mission of providing affordable education and advancing California’s economic growth by continuously improving the state’s workforce.

The California Community College Initiative has qualified for placement on the ballot in the next statewide election on February 5, 2008. Supporters submitted more than 900,000 signatures in January.
