Examples include: advocacy at the state Legislature and/or state Chancellor's Office (including the California Community Colleges Board of Governors); and holding positions in statewide faculty organizations.

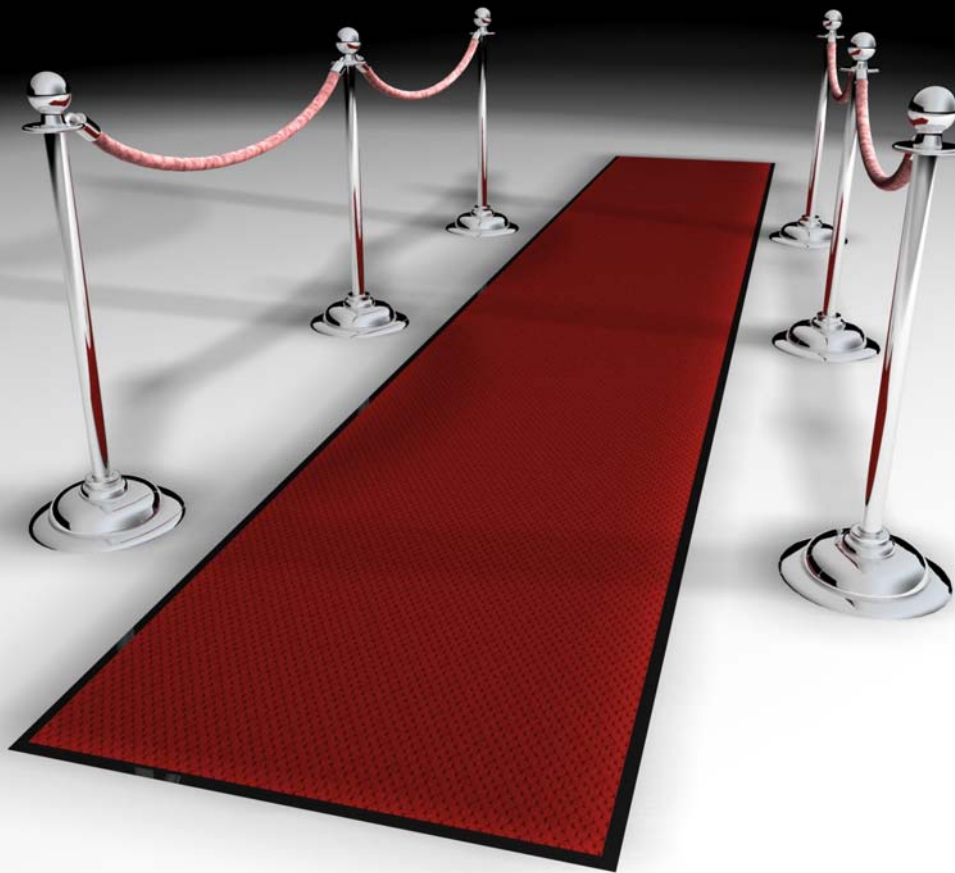
