I. Academic Renewal Taskforce Update

- A. Public Comment is now closed; next Board meeting is scheduled for January 13th, 2026
- B. In response to public comments received during the 45-day public comment period and feedback received at the Board of Governors meeting on September 16, 2025, the Chancellor's Office is recommending tabling the proposed amendments to Title 5, California Code of Regulations, section 55046, "Academic Renewal Without Course Repetition" temporarily. This action is recommended so that Chancellor's Office staff can have more time to consider the impact and effect of a number of proposals specifically related to this specific section and engage further in the consultative process so the final academic renewal criteria and processes can meet the diverse needs and capacities of local districts while facilitating and supporting student success.
- C. The Chancellor's Office is convening the committee to proactively follow-up on the momentum from Tuesday's Board of Governor's meeting, during which the Board voted to approve the regulation changes as attached from this group.
- D. The changes pertaining to Academic Renewal, Section 55046, were tabled for reconsideration to ensure alignment with institutional needs and student access. These proposed changes (currently marked as underlined and struck through) will be reviewed in-depth at our upcoming meeting with the intention to academic renewal changes forward at an upcoming Board meeting.
