- 1. 2023 Bill Package Discussion Bills to be presented at October board meeting
 - Part-time Faculty workload reduction evident Research this for the 2024 package
 - i. Prohibit colleges from charging PT faculty for parking
 - 1. Expand to students
 - 2. Needs more research
 - Centralizing healthcare funds Put together study or committee to figure this out
 - Would work with our labor allies on this
 - ii. Investigate COBRA option
 - iii. Concerns about local autonomy
 - Compensation for professional development and shared governance
- Expanded leave (budget ask aligned with childcare ask)
 - Pregnancy/birth leave Committee recommends a specific bill
- Academic freedom
 - CCC faculty rights to academic freedom must be collectively bargained
 - AF is an accreditation requirement but is not necessarily protected
 - Some districts (College of the Redwoods) have strong AF protections in their union contracts that may be worth codifying.
 - Is there a way to expand in the 10+1 where boards can't create this without faculty buy-in?
- Enrollment bill

- Repeatability of courses (Title 5 regulation)
- Funding for embedded tutors
- Data requirements and timeline
- Expansion of BA degrees target healthcare sector, region
 - Define "duplication" of programs what does "intersegmental agreement" mean? Consultation? Or CSU approval.
