SCFF Potential Legislative Fixes

- c.
 - Base Allocation – lower center thresholds, increase base funding for centers (e.g. City College), hold harmless as base (increase per FTES to reach hold harmless amount)
 - FTES 70% - potential modifications – increase per FTES dollar amount, reduce units to make FTES closer to body count
 - Supplemental 20% - Add cost of living adjustment
 - Success 10% - Remove cap, eliminate
 - Extra funds: Eliminate CalBright – use 20 million for SCFF bonuses
