

## Membership and Leadership Committee April 21, 2023 Meeting Notes

## I. Membership

- a. Recruitment
  - i. New Recruitment Efforts:
    - 1. Wendy is still engaging in conversations with the LACCD to consider a contract membership.
      - a. Kim attended a communication department meeting at LACC to talk about ways to be more active and join FACCC. She talked with Sarah Cracciola-Garcia, who is active in the AFT 1521 and is willing to talk with Wendy about more possible internal support.
      - The Committee will continue to talk about what would be an appropriate cost for institutional membership and suggestions for marketing.
    - 2. The Committee made a commitment to try new recruiting tactics at the Fall ASCCC plenary.
      - a. Discussions revolve around trying to create an atmosphere more attractive for conversations (seating areas and receptions) that can help recruit new members both for FACCC and more actionable work such as legislative visits and commitment to committees.
- b. **Regional Workgroups**: The Committee planned the agenda for the San Diego regional meeting on May 12<sup>th</sup> at San Diego Mesa College.
  - i. The meeting will focus on creating a participatory meeting. The meeting currently has approximately 30 people.
    - 1. The agenda is as follows:
      - a. <u>Session 1</u>: A "Who's Who" of California Policy and governance groups;
      - <u>Session 2</u>: Interactive group work considering ways in which participants can be more active at the local, regional, and state levels.
      - c. **Session 3**: Advocacy training—how to get active.
