- The committee discussed what we worked on last year to meet FACCC Strategic Priorities.
 - Continue to reimage FACCC's values, roles, and leadership within CCCs.
 - Committee briefly talked about more ways to cross committee pollinate
 - Increase FACCC membership and other revenue streams
 - Membership drive:
 - Talked about the accomplishments of last year (e.g., one-pager completed)
 - Discussed how to get materials developed last year onto campuses.
 - Reported on the regional meetings that happened in the spring
- Preview--What should we be doing next?
 - Regional Meetings:
 - Discussed returning to LACCD and SDCCD as well as possibly colleges in the Sacramento area.
 - Identify a "Campus Champion" that could help us mobilize our regional groups.
 - Discussed whether it would make sense to align FACCC regions with ASCCC regions.
 - Considered whether it would be feasible to have regular regional meetings
 - Event Recruitment:

- The committee considered doing something more creative to gain members at events
 - Talked about hosting some type of reception at ASCCC Fall Plenary
 - Discussed having a direct and clear message about what FACCC is and why to join when given opportunities such like speaking at general assembly at plenary
 - Considered the possibility of a creative approach to our "recruitment" table.
 - Discussed the "Faculty Lobby" where a comfortable talking area could be used to draw people in.
 - Talked about having well connected members in the "lobby" to help FACCC connect with new faculty.
 - Talked about other tools such as dart boards, or "spin the wheel" for swag or other incentives to join.

• Other Recruitment Efforts:

- Dialogued about ways to change the FACCC culture so we all accept the role of recruiter, all the time
- Discussion included a possible A&P panel on how to do effective recruiting
