#### **BLM Call to Action**

- Do we create something new or should we just endorse what folks are doing?
- Equity Funding Formula: What can FACCC do about re-evaluating the funds that need to be redirected to black students.
- Promise Program: black students are not getting the PP, is this a conversation that should be held at the state level and facilitated by FACCC?
- The FACCC legislative committee and policy committee could be part of this conversation to help our committee come up with a plan. It's something that legislators and the Chancellor's office needs to provide guidance
- Tool kit for how to evaluate equity gaps.
- Our committee charge: without guidance on how equity funding is distributed on campuses is very difficult to focus on PD training. We want a conversation with legislators and the Chancellor's office to come up with a plan and put money behind it. We put money where our values are regardless of the circumstances. Where are institutions putting their dollars? This may be a policy issue.

- A&P conference should have a session on tapping into folks that represent our system, invite black faculty and students to do the session.
