1. A&P Session

- <u>Title</u>: Valuing Student Voices: Working together towards Advocacy
- <u>Description</u>: A Panel facilitated conversation where audience members will hear lessons learned from panelists' experience to encourage dialogue on the steps necessary to successfully advocate on campus. Participants will have the opportunity to practice advocacy steps during the session. The goal is to empower students and faculty with the confidence of ultimately turning advocacy into action and implementing meaningful change locally.
- <u>Structure</u>:
 - 1st 20 minutes is panel talking, next is breakout(?)- 35 minutes, then debrief last 15 minutes
 - Mock discussions- within the groups- Divide audience into groups, potentially have panelists guide groups during practice, PDC member attendees can also help
