FACCC RESPONDS TO CALBRIGHT AUDIT

SACRAMENTO, Calif. – The Faculty Association of California Community Colleges (FACCC) has issued the following statement from Evan Hawkins, FACCC Executive Director, on the state’s audit of Calbright College:

“We’re grateful the Legislature recognized the importance of holding Calbright accountable by passing this audit last year. We are unsurprised by the critical findings. Calbright is inherently flawed and no amount of time can fix its inability to effectively serve students.

As our 115 accredited colleges have stepped up to serve nearly all students online, the audit shows Calbright continues to serve a small number of students who are not supported enough to become successful in their goals. Simply put, Calbright is falling far short of its promise.

FACCC will continue to advocate for the elimination of Calbright College through the budget process and Assemblymember Evan Low’s bill, AB 1432.”
