**FACCC RESPONDS TO THE SUPREME COURT'S RECENT DECISIONS**

*SACRAMENTO, Calif.* – The Faculty Association of California Community Colleges, the statewide professional membership association that advocates solely for all California Community College faculty, has issued the following statement on the Supreme Court's recent decisions:

“This week's decisions by the Supreme Court to protect Dreamers by upholding the Deferred Action for Children Arrivals (DACA) program and defend the LGBTQ community from workplace discrimination are necessary rulings for our country and our community colleges. As the most diverse system of higher education in the country, California's Community Colleges and its faculty recognize the strength of its diversity and the importance of supporting its students who face discrimination.

Both of these rulings are critical steps in the right direction, but the work continues and the faculty of the California Community Colleges remain committed to fighting prejudice and bigotry in their classrooms, at their colleges, and at the state and federal levels.”
